The competent authority has been pleased to approve the recommendations of the Anomaly Committee constituted under Rule-24 of Federal Levies Force (Amended) Service Rules, 2013 dated 8th April, 2013 to further amend Rule-2(1)(b), Schedule-I of Rules-4(2) and Rule-17 and its related Schedule-IV as under:

Rule-2(1)

- (b) "Commandant" means Commandant of the Force, who shall be Political Agent of the Agency or, as the case may be, Deputy Commissioner for FRs in their respective jurisdiction; or Deputy Secretary (Administration) of the Department of Administration, Infrastructure and Coordination, FATA Secretariat in respect of FATA Secretariat Levies Force".


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Rule-17 Retirement. (1) All uniform levy personnel shall retire as per Schedule-IV or he may opt for retirement after completion of 25 years of regular service and no extension in service beyond retirement shall be granted.

(2) All non-uniform personnel shall retire from service on attaining the age of superannuation i.e. 60 years or he may opt for retirement after completion of 25 years of regular service and no extension in service beyond retirement shall be granted.

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
